

During the journey, you can enjoy panoramic views of Aswan's riverside landscape.Upon arrival at the Nubian village, you'll be greeted by local residents with hospitality. You'll have the opportunity to learn about their lifestyle, traditions, and culture. Visiting their traditional mud-brick houses offers insight into their daily lives.Moreover, it's common to enjoy traditional Nubian music and dances during the visit. ## Day 5: Kom Ombo and Edfu (Nile Cruise)

After breakfast on board, sail to Kom Ombo, where you can visit the Twin Temple of Kom Ombo, where you will learn about Sobek (the crocodile god) and Horus (the falcon god), whose monuments decorate each half of the temple. Lunch on board, sailing to Edfu.

Visit to the Temple of Edfu, the best preserved in the ancient world. The monument is dedicated to the falcon god, Horus. Return to the cruise. Afternoon tea on the deck. Navigation towards Esna. Dinner and overnight on board. Meals included: breakfast, lunch and dinner

### Day 6: Luxor (Nile Cruise)

Breakfast on board. Start your visit in Luxor. You will visit the western part of the city, where we will visit the Valley of the Kings, burial place of the pharaohs of the New Kingdom, the Temple of Hatshepsut that was built by the architects of the New Empire during the 15th century BC in Deir El-Bahari and The Colossi of Memnon famous for its red granite. Return to the cruise. Lunch on board. Visit the Luxor Temple, built during the New Kingdom. It was linked to the Temple of Karnak through an avenue with sphinxes. Visit the Karnak Temple, the most influential religious center. The main temple was dedicated to the god Amun.

- Transfer by private vehicle to the city of Hurghada on the Red Sea

## Day 8: Hurghada (The Red Sea)




